

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Our focus at the beginning of the year is settling the children, in particular forming positive relationships with adults and each other. The children will be learning the class expectations and the vital foundations of what it means to be a 'good learner'. Through their interactions and playing group games, they will learn to share and take turns and will be provided with opportunities to resolve disagreements independently.

Literacy

The initial focus is on recognising familiar words and signs, such as their name. The children will be encouraged to find and write their name, as well as mark making through different medium.

After a few weeks, the children will begin phonics, with a focus on hearing and saying the initial sounds in words.

Expressive Arts and Design

The children will begin to build up a repertoire of songs and dances. They will learn to use simple tools safely and creatively and will be encouraged to introduce their own storylines into their play.

Physical Development

To support children's writing, we will initially focus on children showing a preference for a dominant hand, then moving to the correct pencil hold. This will involve strengthening the muscles through fine motor activities to provide control.

The children will be supported with remaining dry and clean throughout the day, and understanding the importance of hygiene through regular hand washing.

Our Christian Value for this term is Friendship.

Communication and Language

Our topic this term is 'Who Am I?' The children will be given opportunity through our weekly 'Special Children' to discuss themselves and their lives, encouraging speaking but also with a significant focus on listening to others. They will be supported in putting their hand up to speak and concentrating on what someone has said.

Through stories, the children will express their views and answer questions.

Understanding The World

Following our topic, the children will talk about significant events in their own experiences and explore some of the things that makes them unique. We will look at the features of their own immediate environment with a focus on Brixton. I pads will be used to enhance their learning.

Mathematics

The main focus during this term is on place value. The children will be ordering numbers to 20, selecting the correct numeral for the amount of objects and counting an irregular arrangement.

We will also explore 2D and 3D shapes, creating and describing patterns.
